The 2020 Barolo vintage, shaped by the pandemic, yielded wines of balance, elegance, and early approachability. Generous fruit, lively acidity, fine tannins, and vibrant color give both charm and structure. More ready and refined than 2019, if perhaps less long-lived, it has proven deeply enjoyable.

Le Macchiole is one of Tuscany's most iconic estates—renowned for championing single-variety wines in a region where Bordeaux blends once dominated the narrative. Thanks to the support of our trusted importer in Thailand, we are fortunate to offer a selection of carefully cellared older vintages for our guests to enjoy.

Founded in 1983 by Eugenio Campolmi and his wife, Cinzia Merli, Le Macchiole was among the very first small wineries to help shape modern Bolgheri. At a time when most producers leaned into blends of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot, Campolmi took a bold path: he planted Cabernet Franc, Merlot and Syrah on the Tuscan coast. We have chosen to showcase several vintages of Messorio, their pure Merlot expression, as Merlot remains the most emblematic international grape in Bolgheri and stands alongside notable benchmarks such as Cont'Ugo from Antinori and Masseto from Frescobaldi.
