Our focus has been on classic wine regions and benchmark producers, complemented by thoughtful discoveries that express their origin with honesty and precision. You will find a strong foundation in Europe, where tradition, soil, and climate continue to define the world's most enduring wines. Alongside these, we have selected expressive wines from the New World and emerging regions chosen not for scale, but for individuality and clarity.

As the list unfolds, particular attention has been given to the second half, where time becomes a central theme. Here, you will discover a carefully assembled collection of mature wines and vertical selections, offering a rare opportunity to explore how great estates evolve across vintages, and how consistency and nuance coexist over the years. These wines are not only scarce, but also deeply expressive and especially rewarding at the table.

Champagne occupies a place of distinction within this section, with a strong focus on vintage Champagnes and grower-producers whose wines speak clearly of origin, season, and soil.

GROWER CHAMPAGNE

Grower Champagne refers to Champagne produced by the same family that grows the grapes, vinifies the wine, and bottles it under their own name. This estate-focused approach highlights individual vineyards, villages, and soils, rather than a blended house style. The result is Champagne with a strong sense of terroir, authenticity, and remarkable character and precision.

Bottling meant that the sparkle created during fermentation could be preserved only for wines of Champagne, marking the birth of Champagne as we know it today.

LOW INTERVENTION

Natural wine is generally agreed to be wine with only minimum ‘intervention’ in the naturally occurring fermentation process, without fining or filtration. It is farmed biodynamically and made without adding or removing anything in the cellar or using additives or processing. We prefer the term ‘low intervention’ as wine always needs someone to train the vines, process and contain the fruit, bottle the resulting wine etc... Low intervention winemaking and natural winemaking aim to produce wines that are an honest expression of the vineyard they grew, of the land, climate and year, and of the gentle care taken by human hands to

OVERSIZED BOTTLES

“A magnum bottle of wine is the perfect size for two people if one of them isn’t drinking”. While that may be a bit of an exaggeration, it’s true that magnum bottles are excellent choices for group imbibing. Magnum bottles also have unexpected benefits. Although the itself doubles in size, the cork typically does not. Since corks are not entirely airtight, a small amount of oxygen seeps into any bottle over time, aging and developing the juice itself. Therefore, magnum bottles expose double the amount of wine to roughly the same

LES VINS DU JURA

Nestled in eastern France between Burgundy and the Swiss border, Jura, France's smallest wine region, is also renowned for its delicious Comté cheese. Jura is famed for oxidative wines matured under a veil of yeast, alongside precise, mineral-driven ouillé styles. The Vin Jaune on our list comes from the village of Château-Chalon—for the Jura what Romanée-Conti is for Burgundy. Made exclusively from a grape called Savagnin, Vin Jaune is aged for a minimum of six years in barrel without topping up, developing under a natural yeast veil that gives remarkable savoury complexity, intensity, and longevity. It is bottled in the distinctive 62 cl clavelin, a traditional size reflecting the volume remaining after extended ageing.

MONTRACHET OF THE PFALZ



It is impossible to overstate the importance of the Kirchenstück vineyard site for viticulture in the Pfalz. Surrounded by other famous vineyard sites of the town of Forst, such as the Jesuitengarten, Ungeheuer or Pechstein, this vineyard, which is only 3.6 hectares in extent, holds an outstanding position. In the royal Bavarian vineyard classification of 1828, the Kirchenstück was the only vineyard site to be rated with the maximum score of 65 points. It is said that two centuries before this in the Thirty Years of War, the Spanish general Fragipani expressed his reverence for this site, and ordered his soldiers to show their respect for this vineyard site by saluting it.

The Kirchenstück site in Forst is a gift of nature, unique in Germany in its complexity and distinctiveness. Nowhere else does a dry Riesling grow with greater complexity and at the same time with such elemental power and expression. This wine develops slowly at first, only after years of bottle ageing does it reveal its inner values to the wine connoisseur, which make this wine a true masterpiece: the unique terroir character, interwoven with the vintage characteristics.

This wine combines body and power with beguiling elegance, a wealth of concentrated aromas is combined with the most elegant brilliance. The final “Wagnerian” chord on the finish appears to disappear into eternity, and leaves many a taster simply speechless. A wine that cannot be appreciated in a passing moment.
